HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS



Mario Bergoglio Born on December 17, 1936 in Buenos Aires
(Archdiocese of Buenos Aires – Argentina)
Baptized on December 25, 1936
Enters the novitiate of the Society of Jesus, March 11, 1958
Ordained to the Priesthood on December 13, 1969
Named Auxiliary Bishop of Buenos Aires, May 20, 1992
Ordained Auxiliary Bishop, May 27, 1992
Named Archbishop of Buenos Aires, February 28, 1998
Elevated to the College of Cardinals, February 21, 2001
Elected Pope, March 13, 2013
266th Successor of St. Peter



BIOGRAPHY OF POPE FRANCIS

Jorge Mario Bergoglio was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, on December 17, 1936. Son of Italian immigrants, his father Mario was an accountant employed by the railways, and his mother Regina Sivori was a committed wife dedicated to raising their five children. He graduated as a chemical technician and then chose the path of the priesthood, entering the Diocesan Seminary of Villa Devoto. On March 11, 1958, he entered the novitiate of the Society of Jesus. He completed his studies in the humanities in Chile, and returned to Argentina in 1963 to graduate with a degree in philosophy from the Colegio de San José in San Miguel. From 1964 to 1965 he taught literature and psychology at Immaculate Conception College in Santa Fé, and in 1966 he taught the same subjects at the Colegio del Salvatore in Bunos Aires. From 1967 to 1970, he studied theology and obtained a degree from the Colegio of San José. On December 13, 1969, he was ordained a priest by Archbishop Ramón José Castellano. He continued his formation between 1970 and 1971 at the University Of Alcalá de Henares, Spain, and on April 22, 1973, made his final profession with the Jesuits. Returning to Argentina, he was novice master at Villa Barilari, San Miguel; professor at the Faculty of Theology of San Miguel; consulter to the Province of the Society of Jesus, and also Rector of the Colegio Máximo. On July 31, 1973, he was appointed Provincial of the Jesuits in Argentina, an office he held for six years. He then resumed his work in the university sector and from 1980 to 1986 served once again as Rector of the Colegio de San José, as well as parish priest, again in San Miguel. In March 1986 he went to Germany to finish his doctoral thesis; his superiors then sent him to the Colegio del Salvador in Buenos Aires and next to the Jesuit Church in the city of Córdoba as

spiritual director and confessor. On May 20, 1992, Pope John Paul II appointed him titular Bishop of Auca and Auxiliary of Buenos Aires. On May 27, he received episcopal ordination from Cardinal Antinio Quarracino, Archbishop of Buenos Aires. He was immediately appointed Episcopal Vicar of the Flores district and on December 21, 1993, was also entrusted with the office of Vicar General of the Archdiocese. On June 3, 1997, he was named of Coadjutor Archbishop of Buenos Aires. About nine months later, upon the death of Cardinal Quarracino, he succeeded him on February 28, 1998, as Archbishop, Primate of Argentina and Ordinary for Eastern Catholic in Argentina who do not have an Ordinary of their own rite. Three years later at the Consistory of February 21, 2001, Pope John Paul II created him Cardinal, assigning him the title of San Roberto Bellarmino. In October 2001, he was appointed General Relator to the 10th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops on the Ministry of Bishops. In 2005, he was elected President of the Argentine Bishops' Conference and then, in 2008, reconfirmed for a further three-year term. In April 2005, he took part in the Conclave in which Pope Benedict XVI was elected. Until the beginning of the recent sede vacante, he was a member of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, the Congregation for the Clergy, and the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Apostolic Life, the Pontifical Council for the Family, and the Pontifical Commission for Latin America. He was elected Supreme Pontiff on March 13, 2013



THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

The Church had its beginning in Palestine after the historic Pentecost in Jerusalem. Then, it spread to other regions of the world. As it spread, certain cities became centers of Christian life and missionary endeavors-notably, Jerusalem, Antioch, Alexandria and Constantinople in the East and Rome in the West of the Roman Empire – India and Mesopotamia outside the Roman Empire. Each center developed its own practices of worship. These practices became diffused throughout their spheres of influence. These various groups of the faithful were held together by a hierarchy of their own. Thus, separate Rites or Individual Churches came into existence. But they were organically united in the Holy Spirit through the same faith and sacraments but grew with different liturgy, discipline, spirituality and theology. Hence the Catholic Church is a communion of individual Churches.

1. East and West

The ecclesial distinction of East and West came into existence at the end of the third century. It was Emperor Diocletian who for the convenience of Government made this division of the Roman Empire. Eastern Empire was also known as the Byzantine Empire, because its capital was Byzantium (Constantinople). Based on this division, the Church also came to be known as Western and Eastern. The Church that developed in and around Rome was called the Western Church or the Latin Church and the other Churches that developed in the other five centers either in the Eastern Roman Empire or even more east to it were called Eastern Churches. These centers were Alexandria, Antioch, Constantinople (all in the Eastern Roman Empire), Armenia and Chaldea (further East to Eastern Roman Empire). Under the influence of these basic five Eastern liturgical families, there came into existence different individual

Churches which now are numbered 23. Hence, 23 Eastern Churches and the Latin Church form the Catholic Church and they are equal in importance, dignity, rights and obligations. The Syro-Malabar Church in India was established by St. Thomas, the Apostle in 52 A.D. Because of its relationship with and influence of the East Syrian Church though it is an Individual Church, it is counted in the Chaldean (East Syrian) family. The Sui Iuris Churches are listed here according to their Ecclesial Tradition and juridical status.



ARCHBISHOP LUIGI BONAZZI



His Excellency the Most Reverend LUIGI BONAZZI Apostolic Nuncio to Canada

Archbishop Luigi Bonazzi was born in Gazzaniga, in the province of Bergamo, Italy, on June 19, 1948. He was ordained a priest on June 30, 1973, for the Diocese of Bergamo. Having obtained a Doctorate in Education, he entered the diplomatic service of the Holy See on March 25, 1980. He has served in the diplomatic missions of the Holy See in Cameroon, Trinidad and Tobago, Malta, Mozambique, Spain, the United States of America, Italy and Canada. On June19, 1999, he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to Haiti. He has since served as Apostolic Nuncio to Cuba (beginning March 30, 2004), and in the Baltic Countries (Lithuania and Estonia, beginning March 14, 2009, and Latvia, beginning March 25, 2009). The Holy Father named Archbishop Bonazzi Apostolic Nuncio to Canada on December 18, 2013



CANADIAN CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS (CCCB)

The CCCB is the Assembly of the Bishops of Canada. It was founded in 1943 and officially recognized by the Holy See in1948. Since the Second Vatican Council, it became part of a worldwide network of Episcopal Conferences established in 1965 as an integral part of the life of the universal Church. The Conference provides ways for assisting the Canadian Bishops in their common pastoral responsibilities and in different areas. The CCCB is involved in matters of national and international scope, and pro-vides the Bishops a forum to discuss their ministry, the life of the Church and major current questions.

1. The Executive Committee of CCCB

The Executive Committee has four members: the President, Vice President and two Co-Treasurers, all elected by the Plenary Assembly. Each member has a two-year term. The Executive Committee meets about six times each year. It reports to the Permanent Council and is mainly responsible for promoting and coordinating Conference initiatives, for carrying out the decisions of the Plenary Assembly and the Permanent Council, and for administering and dealing with current and urgent matters.

7. Ecclesiastical Jurisdictions

7.1 Diocese and Archdiocese

A Diocese is a portion of the People of God entrusted to a Bishop with the cooperation of the Presbyterium.

An Archdiocese is a metropolitan diocese entrusted to an Archbishop.

7.2 Eparchy and Archeparchy

An Eparchy is a portion of the People of God entrusted to a Bishop, who, in the Eastern Churches is called an Eparchial Bishop. An Archeparchy is a metropolitan diocese entrusted to an Archbishop who is called an Archeparch.

7.3 Military Ordinariate

A portion of the People of God entrusted to a Bishop who is called a Military Ordinary, and whose faithful are members of the Armed Forces.

7.4 Personal Ordinariate

An ecclesiastical jurisdiction instituted by Pope Benedict XVI in 2009, incorporating those Anglican faithful wishing to enter as a

group into full communion with the Catholic Church. A personal ordinariate has been established for the United States and Canada, with its see in Houston, Texas.

7.5 Personal Prelature

An ecclesiastical jurisdiction constituted by a particular group of faithful entrusted to a Prelate who is a Bishop and its proper Ordinary, with priests and deacons to assist him. Much like the military and the personal Ordinaries, the jurisdiction of the Prelate is personal, not territorial. The Prelature of the Holy Cross and Opus Dei is international and develops its pastoral activities in Canada as well.



SYRO- MALABAR CHURCH

1. Brief History

St Thomas, one of the Apostles of Christ, after receiving the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, set about the mission of spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ to the whole world. A review of the life of St Thomas will prove how he fulfilled this great mission in India. According to the tradition, St. Thomas came by sea and landed at Kodungalloor (Cranganore) the capital of the Chera Empire in the year 52 A.D. He baptised several families in Kodungalloor and Palayur (Trichur). St Thomas preached the gospel wherever he went and founded churches. According to Malabar tradition St. Thomas founded seven churches, they are in Cranganore, Quilon, Chayal, Kokkamangalam, Niranam, Paravur and Palayur. From there he went

to Coromandel and suffered martyrdom near the Little Mount in Tamilnadu. His body was brought to the town of Mylapore and was buried in a holy shrine. According to "Ramban songs" St. Thomas converted 17550 people. He ordained priests and consecrated Bishops. The Apostle consecrated Kepa, a native, as Bishop of Kodungalloor and as the head of St. Thomas Christians and Paul as the Bishop of Mylapore. It is worth mentioning that the Apostle gave his followers a way of worship suited to their climate, culture and customs. Since 4th century, the Church in India started communication with the East Syrian Church and soon began to introduce Liturgical books and share rites. Thus, the Indian Church became a member of the Syro- Chaldean Patriarchate for practical purpose, not for doctrinal reasons. The head of the Indian Church was called The Metropolitan and Gate of All India and had jurisdiction all over the country. The Metropolitan See of India was called the See of St. Thomas. When the Chaldean prelates came to India as the spiritual heads of the independent Metropolitan province under the East Syrian Patriarch, the administration of the Indian Church was done by a native priest with the title Archdeacon of all India or Jathikkukarthavian. The residence of the Metropolitan was first at Kodungallur, then Angamaly etc. Because of the close association of the St. Thomas Christians with the East Syrian Church, the Indian Church of St. Thomas is classified in history under the Chaldean matrix of rites, as we read in CCEO C.28\2.

As Pope Pius XII said "during the centuries that India was cut off from the west and despite many trying vicissitudes, the Christian communities formed by the Apostle conserved intact the legacy he left them, and as soon as the sea passage at the close of the 15th century offered a link with their fellow Christians of the west, the union with them was spontaneous (AAS, XLV (1953) PP. 96 97). Thus, the Syro-Malabar Church, as Pope John Paul II said,

"Never severed from the communion with the Church of Rome, in a continuity that the enormous geographic distance has never been able to break. ("Insegnamenti Giovanni PauloII." III/2. Roma, 1980, P. 513). In the XV and XVI centuries the Metropolitans of the St Thomas Christians, who were then East Syrians, took Angamaly as their residential See. (cf. Bulls of Pope Julius III dated 10 March 1553 and 4 May 1553 in Giamil, "Genuinae Relations...." Rome 1902, PP. 17-18-24). In the history of the St. Thomas Christians the arrival of the Portuguese missionaries to India during the 16th century was a turning point. The western missionaries helped the growth of the Indian Church, at the same time it also distorted the juridical and liturgical identity of the St. Thomas Christians.

After the Synod of Udayamperoor (Diamper) in the year 1599, Mgr. Francis Roz, a Portuguese missionary, was appointed the first Latin Bishop for the Metropolitan See of St. Thomas Christians. On the 4th of August 1600 the Portuguese Padroado jurisdiction was extended to Kodungalloor and the Archdiocese of Angamaly was reduced as a suffragan to the Archdiocese of Goa. The residential See of the bishop was transferred from Angamaly to Kodungalloor in 1607 in the light of the letter of permission of Pope Paul V, dated 20th August 1605. On December 22nd, 1608, the Metropolitan status of the See of Kodungalloor was restored by Pope Paul V. He ordered the geographical division of Cochin and Kodungalloor -Angamaly (cf. Bull of Pope Paul V dated, 12th October, 1609 "Bullarium Patronatus Portugalliae" Vol II, P. 14) as a compromise formula for settling a jurisdictional dispute between the Bishop of Cochin and Bishop Francis Roz of Kodungalloor - Angamaly. On 22nd December 1610 Archbishop Menezes of Goa issued a decree restricting the jurisdictional rights of the Metropolitan of St. Thomas Christians to certain areas in the present states of Kerala, Karnataka, Tamilnadu and Andhra Pradesh (cf. "Bullarium Romanu..." Vol. XI PP. 606-608).

The Policy of latinisation by the missionaries caused dispute and resistance among the St. Thomas Christians and it resulted in a revolt in the year 1653 called "Coonan Cross Oath" and the ensuing fraction of Puthenkoottukar. To remedy this situation the Propaganda jurisdiction was also introduced on the St Thomas Christians. The St. Thomas Christians were then divided among themselves under the two Latin Jurisdictions of Padroado and Propaganda. And the rebel bishops who headed the Puthenkoottukar in course of time separated themselves from the Catholic communion and became Jacobites. In the 18th century the Metropolitan residence of Cranganore was transferred to the neighbouring catholic centre, Puthenchira. In 1865 the jurisdiction of the East Syrian Patriarch over the Church of the St Thomas Christians was formally terminated by the Apostolic See. In 1886 the Metropolitan See of Cranganore was suppressed and the St Thomas Christians were put under Verapoly which was later raised to the status of an Archdiocese with the establishment of the Latin Hierarchy in India under the Propaganda Fide. The title of 'Metropolitan of Cranganore' was given ad honorem to the Bishop of Damao. When the See of Damao was annexed to that of Goa the Goan Archbishop began to carry the title of Cranganore also. On 20th May 1887, Pope Leo XIII of illustrious memory by the bull Quod Jampridem separated the St. Thomas Christians from Latin jurisdiction and erected for them two apostolic vicariates of Trichur and Kottayam. On 28th July 1896 by the bull Quae rei sacrae, the same Pope reconstituted the two vicariates into three vicariates of Trichur, Ernakulam and Changanacherry and appointed natives as bishops. These Catholic St. Thomas Christians were then called 'The Syro-Malabar Church'.

In 1911 the Vicariate Apostolic of Kottayam was erected for the Southists. By the epoch-making constitution Romani Pontifices of 21st December 1923, Pope Pius XI erected the Syro-

Malabar Hierarchy and thus restored, to some extent, the hierarchical rule of the St. Thomas Christians. But the form of Government was that of a Latin Metropolitan Province. Ernakulam was raised to the Metropolitan status and the eparchies of Trichur, Changanacherry and Kottayam were made its suffragans. In 1955 the territory of jurisdiction was extended to some districts in Tamil Nadu and Karnataka. In 1956 Changanacherry also was raised to the Metropolitan status. By the time the number of eparchies had increased to seven. The growth of the Syro-Malabar Church in the twentieth century is really marvellous. This energetic Church took up missionary challenges and thus from 1962 Syro-Malabar Exarchates began to be established outside Kerala, Chanda being the first. In 1977 the Exarchates were elevated to the status of Eparchies. In 1988 by the Decree: Pro Christifidelibus the Eparchy of Kalyan was erected for the Syro-Malabar migrants in Mumbai, Pune and Nasik. The Syro-Malabar Church, having 12 eparchies in Kerala under two Metropolitans - Ernakulam and Changanacherry - and 9 eparchies outside Kerala under Latin Provinces, was found in an anomalous situation when CCEO was promulgated in 1990. Taking into consideration the age old traditions and the enormous growth of the Apostolic and Indian Church and in order to rectify the above anomaly, Pope John Paul II, by the constitution "Quae Maiori", dated 16 December 1992, raised the Syro-Malabar Church to the status of Major Archiepiscopal Sui iuris Church with the title of Ernakulam-Angamaly. The erection was published on 29th January 1993. The Metropolitan of Ernakulam, Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara, was appointed the first Major Archbishop. The proper territory of the Major Archbishop was determined to be the territory of the two provinces of Ernakulam and Changanacherry. The Installation of the Major Archbishop and the inauguration of the first Synod of Bishops of the Syro-Malabar Major Archiepiscopal Church was held



at Ernakulam on 20th May 1993. From June 7th, 1995 to January 18th, 1997 Mar James Pazhayattil was appointed by the Holy See, as the assistant to Major Archbishop to serve the Syro-Malabar Church due to the ill-health of Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara.

In 1995 the Eparchies of Trichur and Tellicherry were elevated to the Metropolitan status. A new eparchy of Thuckalay was erected in 1996 in the province of Changanacherry. Following the resignation of Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara, Very Rev. Dr. Varkey Vithayathil CSsR was appointed as the Apostolic Administrator in 1996 and as the Major Archbishop in 1999. Bifurcating Tellicherry, the eparchy of Belthangady was erected in 1999. Another Eparchy was erected in Chicago for the Syro-Malabar migrants in February 2001. It is considered to be a remarkable event and milestone in the history of the SyroMalabar Church. Later, the eparchy of Idukki was erected in January 2003. On 21st August 2007 the Eparchy of Badravathi (Karnataka) was erected, bifurcating the Eparchy of Mananthavady. Major Archbishop Mar Varkey Cardinal Vithayathil appointed Mar Bosco Puthur the first Curia Bishop on 18.01.2010 and ordained him Bishop on 13.02.2010. Two new Eparchies, Ramanathapuram (bifurcated from Palghat) and Mandia (bifurcated from Mananthavady and Badravathy) were erected on 18 January 2010. At present the Syro-Malabar Major Archiepiscopal Church is having 18 Eparchies inside its proper territory under 5 Metropolitan sees and 11 Eparchies outside the proper territory and 4 Eparchies outside India. Consequently, upon the demise of the Major Archbishop Mar Varkey Cardinal Vithayathil, Mar George Alencherry (Bishop of Thuckalay) was elected Major Archbishop on 24th May 2011 with the assent of His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI and installed on 25th May 2011. The Pope created him Cardinal in the consistory held in Rome on 18th February 2012. On 6th March 2012 the Eparchy of Faridabad

was erected for the Syro-Malabar migrants in Haryana, Delhi and his Grace Archbishop Kuriakose Bharanikulangara became its First Bishop. The eparchy of Melbourne, the second eparchy of the Syro-Malabar Church outside India after the Eparchy of Chicago was established on 11th February 2014 and Mar Bosco Puthur the Curia Bishop became its First Bishop.

An exarchate was formed for the Syro- Malabar Catholics in Canada on 6 August 2015 with its headquarters at Mississauga and Mar Jose Kalluvelil became the Exarch by the Apostolic Constitution "Spiritualem ubertatem". The Episcopal Ordination of the Bishop and inauguration of the Exarchate took place on 19 September 2015. Later, within 39 months the Exarchate was elevated to the rank of an Eparchy with the title of Mississauga by His Holiness Pope Francis on 22 December 2018. The inauguration of the Eparchy and the installation of Mar Jose Kalluvelil were solemnized on 25 May 2019 by His Beatitude George Cardinal Alencherry, the Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church, at St. Alphonsa Syro-Malabar Catholic Cathedral, Mississauga.

Mar Stephen Chirappanath(Eparchy of Irinjalakuda) was appointed as Titular Bishop of Slebte and Apostolic Visitator for the Syro Malabar faithful of the Europe on 28th July 2016. On the same day Eparchy of Great Britain was established and Mar Joseph Srambickal became its First Bishop. On 10 October 2017, Eparchy of Hosur was erected in Tamilnadu and Mar Sebastian Pozholiparambil was appointed as the first Bishop. On the same the Eparchy of Shamsabad was erected and Mar Raphael Thattil was appointed as the first Bishop.

4. SYNOD OF BISHOPS OF THE SYRO-MALABAR CHURCH

The Synod of Bishops is the Assembly of all the Bishops of the Syro-Malabar Church. Literally it means in its Greek verbal form to travel in company, to have fellowship with, to accompany or to walk together along the same path and in its noun form it signifies an assembly or gathering especially for deliberation. In the ecclesiastical sense the word synod means the assembly of heads of Churches, regularly or canonically convoked to deliberate and legislate on religious affairs. The synodal system of Church structure evolved from the college of apostles who took important decisions collegially. The very being of Church is communion and the synodal structure expresses this ecclesiology of communion with its various principles of autonomy, unity in diversity, equality and the right of every Church to grow and develop which has been very much emphasized in the Second Vatican Council.

The Synod of Bishops canonically convoked and presided over by the Patriarch/Major Archbishop constitutes the supreme authority of a particular Church. It is the legislature, superior tribunal and the electoral college of a particular Church. The Synod of Bishops is not an organ of the Patriarch/Major Archbishop but the supreme authority of a Church, of which the Patriarch/Major Archbishop is the head.

According to the Code of Canons of the Eastern Churches, all and solely ordained bishops of the patriarchal Church wherever they are constituted, excluding those forbidden by law, are members of the synod. Even though, according to CCEO, particular law could have restricted the deliberative vote of those bishops constituted outside the proper territory of the Church, the particular law of the Syro-Malabar Church grants them the same power of deliberative vote as those bishops from within the territory of the Church. Non-Episcopal participation in the synod is excluded totally in accordance with the ancient tradition of the undivided Church.

The First Synod of the Bishops of the Syro-Malabar Church was held on the very same day when the Major Archbishop Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara was installed in office, i.e. on 20 May 1993 and the same session of the Synod that lasted up to 25 May discussed the Synodal Statutes which were later published in the Particular Laws of the Syro-Malabar Church (Synodal News, Vol. 11, No. 1, May 2003).

SYRO-MALABAR CATHOLIC EPARCHY OF MISSISSAUGA



HIS EXCELLENCY MAR JOSE KALLUVELIL

Jose Kalluvelil was born on November 15, 1955 at Thottuva, Kuravilangad, in the Eparchy of Pala, India as the youngest son of Joseph and Annamma. He has four brothers. At the age of four, the family moved to Jellipara, in the Eparchy of Palghat, India. After completing High School studies, he joined St. Mary's Minor Seminary, Thrissur. Major Seminary formation was at St. Thomas Apostolic Seminary, Kottayam, India where he received his



Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy and Theology. He was ordained priest on December 18, 1984 by His Excellency Mar Joseph Irimpen, the first Bishop of Palghat.

Fr. Jose began his priestly ministry on January 15, 1985 at Fathima Matha Church as Asst. Parish Priest and Director of St. Joseph's Boys Home at Agali. In 1989 he was appointed Director of Catechetical Department in the Eparchy of Palghat where he served for 12 consecutive years. During this period he was also the Parish Priest at 3 other parishes: Panthalampadam, Olavakod and Ottapalam. In addition, he served the Eparchy as Diocesan Consultor, Founder Director of Kerala Catholic Students League, Director of Holy Childhood and Bible Apostolate.

In 2001, Fr. Jose was sent to Rome for higher studies. He completed his licentiate in "Theology of Human Mobility" from Pontifical Urban University and Doctorate in "Family Catechesis" from Pontifical Salesian University, Rome. Back from Rome he served as Parish Priest of St. Antony's Church Kottayi, and Fathima Matha Church Kallekad for one year. In 2007 Fr. Jose Kalluvelil was appointed Vicar of St. Raphael's Cathedral Palghat, Manager of St. Raphael's Higher Secondary School and Diocesan Consultor. After five years, in 2012, he was transferred to St. Thomas Forane Church Kanjirapuzha where he worked for one year. In 2013 he was sent to Canada for the pastoral care of St. Thomas Syro-Malabar Community, Toronto.

On August 06, 2015 Fr. Jose Kalluvelil was appointed Exarch of the newly erected Apostolic Exarchate for the Syro-Malabar Catholics in Canada and Titular Bishop of Tabalta by his Holiness Pope Francis. He was ordained Bishop on September 19, 2015. After 3 years, on December 22nd 2018 the exarchate has been elevated into the status of an Eparchy. The inauguration of the Eparchy and the installation of Bishop Jose Kalluvellil were



solemnized on May 25th 2019 by His Beatitude Mar George Cardinal Alencherry, the Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Church.

1. Brief History

"The plans of the Lord stand firm forever; the purposes of his heart through all generations" (Psalm33:11). This brief history is a 'looking back and a moving forward' with the firm plans of the Lord about the Syro-Malabar Catholic Eparchy of Mississauga. The Syro-Malabar Catholics in Canada are a migrant community, with rich cultural and Catholic backgrounds. Although the faithful are scattered and settled among the several Canadian provinces and territories, they have maintained their faith and religious identity through their limited community connections and contacts with their mother Church, the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church in India. From 1960-1980, majority of these communities were relying on the part-time pastoral services of priests from the Syro Malabar Catholic Church and other Catholic Religious Orders from India, who were serving in the different Latin Catholic Dioceses of Canada. We would like to convey our gratitude to those priests who took care of the community; and we gratefully acknowledge the valuable guidance and support of the Archbishops and Bishops who gave their invaluable services to maintain the Syro-Malabar Catholic faith.

From 1980-2015, the Syro-Malabar Catholic Community in Canada grew in size mainly due to the growth of population and by the arrival of new Syro-Malabar Catholic immigrants from India and other countries. Although the accurate number is not identified, based on the available data, there are approximately 23,000 Syro-Malabar Catholics settled in Canada. We gratefully acknowledge the amazing generosity and pastoral support of all Cardinals, Archbishops and Bishops of Canada.

1.1 Erection of the Syro-Malabar Apostolic Exarchate

August 6, 2015 is a memorable day in the history of the Syro-Malabar Catholics in Canada. It was on that day the Holy Father Pope Francis, "Desiring to protect and promote the spiritual riches of the Oriental Churches..." (Cf. Decree of Erection), erected the Apostolic Exarchate for the Syro-Malabar Catholics in Canada and appointed Very Reverend Dr. Jose Kalluvelil as the Apostolic Exarch by the Apostolic Constitution "Spiritualem ubertatem". The Episcopal Ordination of the Apostolic Exarch and the formal inauguration of the Syro-Malabar Exarchate took place on September 19, 2015 at the Church of Virgin Mary and Athanasius Canadian Coptic Centre by His Beatitude George Cardinal Alencherry, the Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church.

Evarchate, we initiated our faith journey with specific Vision and Mission. Our main objectives are, **To Form, To Fortify** and **To Evangelise** the People of God and provide them with all the necessary pastoral care. Based on the promise of Christ: "Seek first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well" (Mt. 6:33), despite of the initial struggle, we could slowly build up the Exarchate from scratch.

1.2 Elevation to Eparchy

The Apostolic Exarchate for the Syro-Malabar Catholics in Canada is elevated to the rank of an Eparchy with the title of Mississauga by His Holiness Pope Francis on 22 December 2018. The inauguration of the Eparchy and the installation of Mar Jose Kalluvelil were solemnized on 25 May 2019 by His Beatitude George Cardinal Alencherry, the Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church, at St. Alphonsa Syro-Malabar Catholic Cathedral, Mississauga. Let's thank God for this ineffable gift, a gift for the missionary zeal, hard work and coordinated efforts of all the People of God in this far-reaching country.



1.3 Decree of Elevation of Eparchy



FRANCIS, BISHOP, SERVANT OF THE SERVANTS OF GOD, for a perpetual memory. It is fitting for everyone wholeheartedly to spend their lives contemplating God's greatness and offering thanksgiving for His sublime mercy because through Jesus, who is our salvation, our spirit rejoices in the eternal divinity (see Venerable Bee, *Expositio in Lucam* 1, 46-47).

Keeping these benefits in mind, Our Apostolic solicitude extends to all the Christian faithful whose spiritual development is opportunely promoted, especially through piety and works of charity.

We therefore, at this time, turn Our attention to the beloved Catholic faithful of the Syro-Malabar Rite residing in Canada and, wishing to promote their spiritual well-being and to provide for their growth, having received the advice and favorable opinion of our Venerable Brother Cardinal George Alencherry, Major Archbishop of Ernakulam-Angamaly, and the Syro-Malabar Synod of Bishops, as well as the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and having heard from our Venerable Brother Cardinal Leonardo Sandri, Prefect of the Congregation for Oriental Churches, by the fullness of Our Apostolic Authority we hereby raise the Apostolic Exarchate in Canada to the rank of an Eparchy with all the rights and privileges related thereto, in accordance with the norms of the Code of Canons of the Eastern Churches. It will be known as the Eparchy of MISSISSAUGA, changing nothing relating to the place of the Cathedral Church or to the seat of the Bishop and the Diocesan Curia. We establish this Eparchy to be immediately subject to the Apostolic See, entrusting it to the heavenly patronage of St. Thomas the Apostle. Its Bishop is a member of the Synod of Bishops of the Syro-Malabar Church. All priests presently exercising their ministry within the territory of the Eparchy are ipso facto, incardinated into the newly erected Eparchy, and seminarians from parishes within the same territory are inscribed into the new circumscription. Other matters are to be arranged in accordance with the norms of the said Code.

May the Lord bestow his mercy upon the pastors and faithful of this eparchy and preserve them from all harm, so that through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, they may merit within the Church of Christ our Savior, through worthy deeds, to obtain the reward of eternal happiness. Finally, we desire that this our Constitution be effective, anything to the contrary not withstanding.

Given in Rome, at St. Peter's, this twenty-second day of December in the Year of Our Lord 2018, the sixth of Our Pontificate.






